The 2024 camper survey results are in!
Here is a snapshot of the survey responses and the impact of camp!

Campers surveyed agreed:

- 95% felt they were included.
- 88% felt they grew in their faith in God.
- 94% had fun.
- 92% felt safe.
- 81% tried something new.
- 82% practiced their faith habits.
- 84% didn't give up when challenged.
- 93% had a great week.

was launched. At the end of 2024, we celebrated the completion of the building projects AND the complete payment of all loans associated with the projects. You completed this HUGE plan. Main Camp

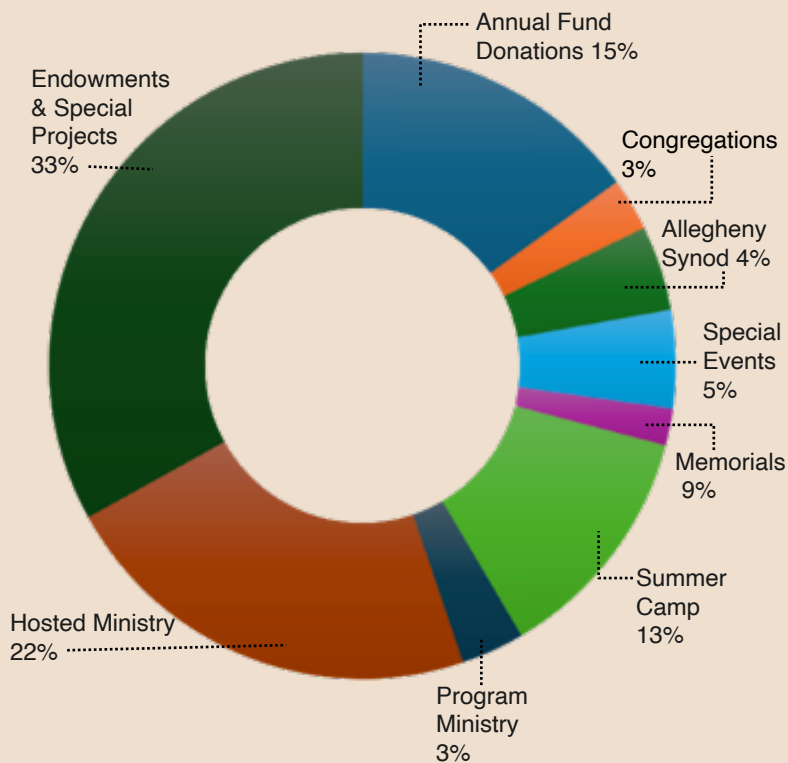

Road projects & Exterior LED Lighting

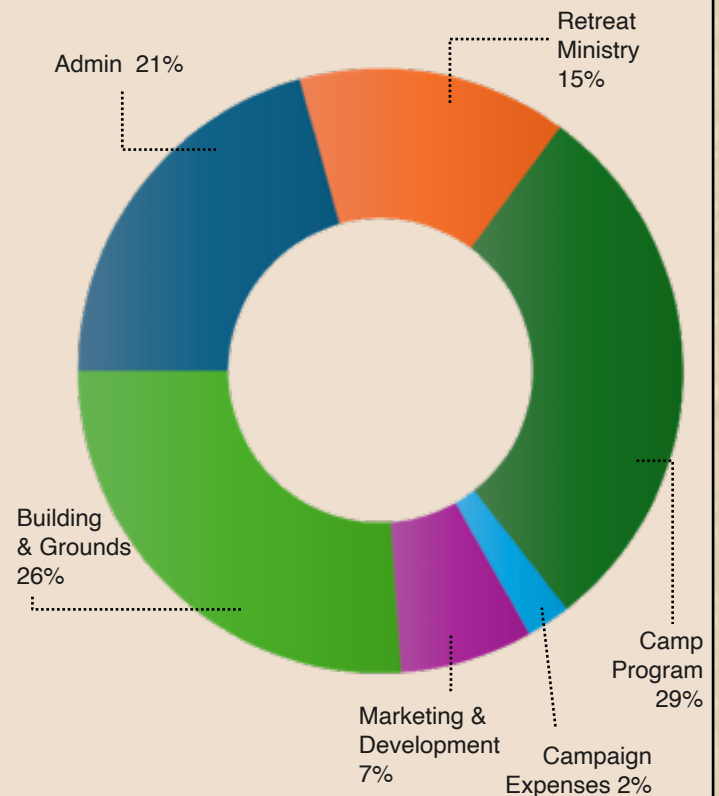
